- When you list relevant coursework, **DO NOT PUT IRRELEVANT COURSES**
 - Karen from HR DOES NOT CARE if you took BBQ Science if you're applying for SWE/Data
 Science Internships
 - Karen from HR **DOES CARE** if you took **Data Structures** or **Systems Programming**
 - In fact, these classes are well known around there
- Make sure everything is relevant and QUANTIFY IMPACT and SPECIFY TOOLs where possible
- ATS systems online are your **bestie**
- And finally, save it as LAST_FIRST_RESUME.pdf

LinkedIn

- Think of it as your **resume** but **on social media**
- Include any activities, experiences, awards, projects, etc on there that you feel are relevant that won't be able to fit into your resume
- Make custom linkedin url
- What you *should* really focus on putting out there
 - The Headline
 - Experience
 - Education
 - Only put UIUC, not your HS
 - Projects or anything that speaks best to you (research, article you wrote, etc)
